# PENNSYLVANIA'S COAL REGION

## SCRANTON, PA

### 4 Days – 3 Nights

*The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.*

- Day 1** Depart from the Hershey Clubhouse and travel to Scranton in Northeastern Pennsylvania on the western edge of the Pocono Mountains. Scranton is the 6th most populous city in Pennsylvania. Along the way you will stop in Easton to visit the **Crayola Experience & Store**. Enjoy lunch on your own, then depart for lodging at a Radisson Hotel, where **dinner** is included at the hotel.
- Day 2** After breakfast, check out and travel to Norwich, NY to visit the Northeast Classic Car Museum to view over 170 classic and vintage cars and 28 motorcycles displayed in 5 connected, climate-controlled buildings. Enjoy lunch on your own in the area, then travel to Lackawaxen, PA for a self-guided visit at the Zane Grey Museum, former home (1905–1918) of renowned western fiction writer, dentist, and amateur baseball player, Zane Grey who was born in Zanesville, OH. Exhibits include photographs, artworks, memorabilia, personal items, manuscripts, and first editions of Grey's books. After **dinner** at a popular restaurant in the area, return to your hotel for a restful evening.
- Day 3** Following breakfast, depart for a visit to the **Steamtown National Historic Site** (Scranton). Explore the grounds, History Museum, Roundhouse, and Rail yard during your visit to this historic railroad museum and heritage railroad. Enjoy lunch on your own, then depart for Hawley, PA for a guided tour of the **Dorflinger Glass Factory Museum**, a regional industrial heritage museum celebrating the history and craftsmanship of the Derflinger glass company (1852–1921) and its visionary leader, Christian Derflinger, who transformed White Mills from a sleepy hamlet on the banks of the Lackawaxen River into a bustling industrial center. Derflinger produced fine lead crystal tableware for U.S. Presidents, governments, and wealthy individuals during the Gilded Age of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Exhibits explore the history of the company, how this remarkable fine cut, etched, engraved, etched glass was made and decorated, and how it was used in society. Exhibits include actual glassblowing, cutting, and engraving equipment from the Dorflinger factory and the restored factory boiler room showing how the factory was powered. After your day of touring, you will enjoy a delicious **dinner** at a popular restaurant in Scranton.
- Day 4** Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then check out and depart for a visit to the **Anthracite Heritage Museum** which preserves the heritage of anthracite coal mining in Pennsylvania. It features exhibits detailing the industrial history of northeastern Pennsylvania with a diverse collection highlighting the harsh working conditions in the mines, mill and factories. Afterwards, depart for the **Lackawanna Coal Mine Tour** where you will take a 4-minute ride on a mine car 300 feet into the earth as you explore the winding, underground mine and tunnels. Your guide will explain the fascinating mining methods and historic, heroic efforts made by mine workers during the days when "coal was king" during the Industrial Revolution. The once abandoned and now restored hard coal mine (*originally opened in 1860*) is a cool 53 degrees year round (*light Jacket is recommended as well as comfortable shoes for the walking portion of the tour.*) After the tour, depart for home with a lunch stop on your own along the way... taking with you lasting memories of Northeastern Pennsylvania.
